Message from our Principal, Justin Perriam

Kia ora koutou,

I hope you all had a good Easter break. It's hard to believe we're nearly at the end of the first term!

On behalf of all Tuia Burnside staff I would like to express our deepest sympathies to both our Malaysian and Taiwanese communities after the recent tragic incidents. We were saddened to first hear of the loss of life of the Malaysian students in the car crash near Pukaki, followed by the damage and loss of life caused by the large earthquake in Taiwan.

Our thoughts and prayers are with every family member, friend, and fellow student who has been affected by these heartbreaking events.

Have a concern?

If you have a concern regarding learning or behaviour the first person to contact is your child's class teacher. A majority of the concerns you may have will normally be sorted at this level. However we do have a procedure to follow if you feel your concern has not been addressed.

End of the day pickup

We are aware that at times there are a number of Cobham students waiting outside of the learning spaces or by the bike/scooter area just before 3pm. We have spoken to Cobham and asked that no Cobham students enter our school grounds until 3pm.

Memorial Ave drop off zone

This will open as a drop-off zone and for pedestrian access from **Monday 8th April** as a trial. To make sure this drop-off area is kept free flowing, please do not park or leave your vehicle. There will be cones placed out to show where you are able to drive.

Due to the surface condition of parts of the carpark we are unable to open the car park for parking until remedial work has been completed. We appreciate your patience as we try to establish a system that will work well for all users.

The six parking spaces closest to the dental clinic are for their use only. Please do not park in these spaces.

Concerns and Complaints Process

Most concerns can be resolved informally by discussions with the people involved.

STEP 1

Your concern is **GENERAL IN NATURE**

OR ...

Involves a particular **STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER**.

Contact the person involved to arrange a time to discuss the matter privately.

Indicate what the concern is about and let them know if you'll bring a support person to the meeting. If the concern is about a student, contact the student's teacher (or principal).

Meet with the person involved to discuss the matter. Be prepared to listen to different points of view and try to work towards a resolution.

This may require another meeting and/or involve senior management.

Is the matter resolved?

Provide feedback as to whether you were satisfied with the outcome, or if the matter is not resolved.

NO FURTHER ACTION REQUIRED

STEP 2

Your concern has **NOT** been resolved by meeting with the person concerned

OR ... does NOT involve a particular student or staff member

OR ... you **DO NOT** wish to approach the person concerned

OR ... involves the principal or a trustee (board member).

Contact the principal, senior management, or board member (as appropriate) to arrange a time to discuss the matter privately.

Indicate what the concern is about, any steps taken to resolve the matter, and let them know if you'll bring a support person to the meeting.

Meet with the appropriate person (as above) and discuss the matter.

Be prepared to listen to different points of view and try to work towards a resolution.

The principal may involve other people to help resolve the concern.

Is the matter resolved?

Provide feedback as to whether you were satisfied with the outcome, or if the matter is not resolved.

NO FURTHER ACTION REQUIRED

STEP 3

Your concern has **NOT** been resolved by previous steps

OR ... your concern is more serious

OR ... your concern is serious and it's not appropriate to contact the principal (senior management) about it.

You can make a formal complaint.

See the school's **Making a Formal Complaint or Serious Allegation** procedure (SchoolDocs).

Put the complaint in writing (email or letter), giving as many facts and details as possible, and any steps taken to resolve the matter.

Include your name, signature, and contact details.

Send to the principal, presiding member (board chair), or deputy board chair/other board member, as appropriate.

Your complaint will be acknowledged.

The school will decide whether a formal investigation is necessary or appropriate. See the **Making a Formal Complaint or Serious Allegation** procedure (SchoolDocs).

If a formal investigation is required, subject to privacy, confidentiality, or other ethical and legal requirements, the school may keep you informed about the investigation process and timeframes, including confirmation of when the matter is concluded.

Kahu 2 have been blowing us away with their creative ideas in writing this term. We have had some wonderful pieces of work created in class showing what fantastic ideas they have.


We love reading about what our classmates have gotten up to on the weekend and what they enjoy.



Whakawhanaungatanga

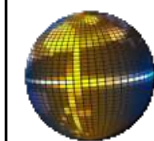
This term in Kiwi Can our main theme is 'Positive Relationships' and this week we are focusing on leadership. Here are some questions you can ask at home:
